YOUNG ADULTS RETREAT 2024

What is it?

A three day, two night retreat (Friday afternoon to Sunday evening) for the young adults.

Where will it be held?

Located on a beachside property in the Gulf Islands, Capernwray Harbour, on Thetis Island, acts as a Retreat Center during the summer and a Bible School from September to May.

When is it?

Friday, June 14, 2024, planning to meet at Blue Mountain Church parking lot at 11:30am. We need to arrive early to the ferry terminal for our sailing, bring a lunch or buy a meal on the ferry! Back to the church on Sunday around 6:00pm.

How will we get there?

We will travel together and pre-arrange rides. We will ask for volunteers to bring their vehicles (money for gas and ferry costs will be provided), and take 2 ferries to arrive to Thetis Island.

Where will we stay?

Capernwray Harbour has well-kept lodges/cabins that we will stay in, with all bedding provided. Men and women will stay in separate accommodations. No separate rooms for couples.

What will it cost?

\$325 per person. Price includes your lodging, meals, activities and travel cost. A \$100 deposit will be due at the registration deadline of December 31, 2023. The remaining amount will be due February 15, 2024.

How do I pay?

Why should I come?

Taking a step away from our busy and sometimes monotonous daily lives is a necessity, Jesus Himself practiced it regularly. Retreats offer a unique opportunity for intentional rest, with little to think about but to enjoy time with God and others. Whether you have been at Blue Mountain for years or this is your first experience with the young adults, you will be blessed by the time spent in community in a beautiful, peaceful area of British Columbia.

What will happen at the retreat?

- A focus on God's Word with teaching sessions, worship in music, quiet time for reflecting.
- Fun activities with the possibility for waterfront time, climbing tower, ropes courses, volleyball, soccer, etc.
- Time together with family-style meals, team-building games, campfire.

What should I bring?
