7. When you first read verse 18, does it seem like it applies to you and your life?  
-In what way is a servant or slave applicable to your situation?
8. How would you explain what 'being called' is referring to in this passage?  
-How does it make you feel to be called this way?

### **READ....Colossians 3:22-25**

10. How does seeing our work and willingness to endure in this way help make it possible?
11. What would you say is the key phrase in this passage?  
*Hint: it has to do with who we are doing this for*
12. How does submitting ourselves to God's will change our attitudes and actions when it comes to living through unfairness and suffering?
13. What can help us endure the unfair suffering we face?  
What can give us encouragement and perseverance?
