- 6. In verse 9, Peter uses the word...'Reviling'. What do you believe it means to 'revile' someone?

 - -What are practical ways we can use 'what we say' to help bless others? (think of ways that don't always involve speaking to someone)

- 8. What do you think may have been happening to David when he wrote this Psalm? **READ 1 Samuel 24:1-12...16-19**
- 9. Does it surprise you that it's believed David wrote this Psalm during this difficult time?
 - -How can David be so positive when his life was threatened?
- 10. What was the result of David's actions toward Saul in 1 Samuel 24?
 -What was Saul's response?
- 11. Do you believe that if we seek to bless others around us...even those who are against us, -that God will bless us?
 - -How do you believe God will bless us?
